## A - EU initiative on Subcontracting

HOTREC will inform about the latest developments on the European Parliament side, with regard to subcontracting - **own initiative draft report** launched by MEP Danielsson (S&D/Sweden) - (2025/2133(INI)). HOTREC to present its <u>position paper</u>. Discussion of next steps.

# **B** - Traineeship Directive

On 24 March 2024, the European Commission published a proposal for a **Directive on Traineeships** (COM(2024) 132 final/2): legislative document.

On 19 June 2025, the Council reached a <u>general approach</u> on the Traineeship Directive. HOTREC will present the main outcome.

HOTREC to present next steps. HOTREC members to report on their advocacy activities.

#### C - EU Talent Pool

On 15 November 2023, the European Commission published a proposal for a Regulation establishing an EU Talent Pool — legislative initiative to be decided both by the European Parliament and the Council.

HOTREC very much welcomes the initiative as the main aim is to create a platform that would put in contact EU employers with third country nationals.

HOTREC will provide the latest updates on the file and will present the next steps.
